



Light Up Vidalia

We are excited to invite you to participate in a community wide Christmas light display. The display will be set up at the new location of Paul Thigpen Chevrolet in Vidalia across from Lowes.

Plots are size 30x30; we have 40 plots and are assigning them on a first come first serve basis.

The total cost is \$100 per plot and this includes all electricity and advertising (TV, radio, & newspaper) for this event. We are working with AEMC to determine the max amount of electricity each plot will have access to.

The Light Display Setup will begin on Monday, November 27th and should be complete by noon on Tuesday, December 5th. Your display must not be removed before Tuesday, January 2nd and should be completely removed by Monday, Jan 8th

We will have a "Light Up Vidalia" event on Tuesday, Dec 5th in conjunction with the Downtown Vidalia Associations' Twelve Days of Christmas at 7PM. We encourage everyone who has a plot to be present for this event.

There will be a random, public drawing held in order to spread community love. \$1000 will be awarded to one of the 40 plots in order to celebrate our 1st light display. This will be a donation paid by the committee and will be given to a local organization chosen by the recipient.

Deadline for Applications and Fees is Monday, November 6th at 3PM. Please bring the attached application and \$100 payment to the Marketing Building at Paul Thigpen Chevrolet.

Once the plots are assigned we will send out more information about community events that we plan to incorporate during our 1st annual Light Up Vidalia.
